4. **New Business**

- **Legislative Update**

HB2261 passed. It redefines Basic Education. It dictates how much money per student, that each district is allotted. Phase I (2011) will be Full Day Kindergarten and Special Education Preschool. Full implementation isn't slated until 2018.

- **District Budget Update**

On April 20th the SVSD Board approved the 2009/10 Reduction Plan. This reduction will be \$4.1m: \$400,000 taken out of extra-curricular activities at the middle school level; \$457,000 taken out of the custodial staffing model; 7.5 FTE reductions at the elementary school level (based on seniority and service in WA.)
